It is with immense pride and a deep sense of accomplishment that we present the **Annual Report for the academic session 2024–2025**.

### **A Year of Excellence: Reflecting on Our Journey**

This academic year marked significant growth, with an increase in the number of sections in Nursery, Standard I, and Standard II. As a result, the total student strength rose to **1,017**, including **93 students enrolled under the RTE quota**.

To support this growth, **two new teaching staff members** were added, bringing the **total number of teachers to 44**, along with **5 non-teaching staff members** who continue to support the school's day-to-day operations.
